Annual water use reports for community water systems outside active management areas are due on **June 1, 2009**. Enclosed is the annual water use report form for calendar year 2008 (January 1 - December 31).

Two options are available for submitting your annual report:

- **Online Electronic Reporting (preferred method):** Online reporting has been simplified this year:
 - Access ADWR's community water system web page at www.azwater.gov/dwr/drought/CWS.html
 - Click on the *eCWS Online Reporting Tool* link
 - Follow the instructions under "First Time User." You will simply enter your e-mail address, and a temporary password will be sent to your account.
 - Once you log-in with your password, enter your 91 number and customer ID from the top of this page.

When you complete the process of entering your data, make sure to print the receipt for your files. If you report online this year, you will receive an e-mail notice next year to remind you to file, and you will not receive a paper form unless requested.

The first system water plans for small community water systems are due to the Arizona Department of Water Resources by **January 2, 2008**. The purpose of these plans is to ensure that Arizona water providers conduct the necessary planning to reduce vulnerability to drought and prevent a potential water shortage situation. The system water plan has three components:

- Water supply plan
- Water conservation plan
- Drought preparedness plan

Online Assistance

- A new and improved system water plan form to fill out and submit. **AVAILABLE ONLINE NOW!**
- An interactive, online tool to assist you in developing the drought preparedness plan. This tool, available by November 16, 2007, will help you determine your vulnerability to drought, and develop drought stages and water management measures.
