



APPLICATION GUIDELINES

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes ("A. R. S.") §§ 41-1008 and 1079, the Department of Water Resources ("Department") provides the following information regarding the application review process.

Necessary Steps and Instructions to Obtain Abandonment Authority

1. Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R12-15-816, well abandonment must be performed by a licensed well drilling contractor or single well licensee. (A single well licensee is a person given a license by this Department that allows drilling or modification of a single, exempt well on land owned by that person.)
2. Except as described below, a well drilling contractor or single well licensee may commence abandoning a well only if the driller has possession of an abandonment card at the well site, issued by the Department in the name of the driller, authorizing the abandonment of a specific well or wells in a specific location. Upon approval of the application, the Department will mail an Abandonment Authorization Card to the designated well drilling contractor or single well licensee. To assist you in understanding the substantive requirements for this application, copies of A.R.S. § 45-594 and Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R12-15-816 are available at the Department Book Store.
3. Information to complete items 1, 2 and 3 may be available from your county tax receipt, your County Assessor's Office or the Notice of Intent to Drill.
4. Information to complete items 4, 7, 8, 9 and 10 are available from your Notice of Intent to Drill or our Records Division at (602)417-2405.
5. Information to complete items 11, 13 and 15 should be available from your driller.
6. Submit **two original Notices**, each signed by the owner, to P.O. Box 458, Phoenix, Arizona, 85004-0458, or hand deliver to 500 North Street, Phoenix, Arizona. If an individual other than the owner signs these notices, an original, **notarized** letter of authorization from the owner must accompany the Notices. **No fee is required to process this application.**

Time Frames for Review of Your Application

Within thirty (30) days after receipt of your application, the Department will determine whether your application should be granted or denied, unless this time is extended as described below. In processing your application, the Department will first determine whether the application is administratively complete (administrative completeness review), and then whether the application meets the substantive criteria established by statute or rule (substantive review). Each of these reviews will be completed within the times stated below. The time for the administrative completeness review plus the time for the substantive review is referred to as the overall time frame.

1) Administrative Completeness Review Time Frame

Within fifteen (15) days after receipt of your application, the Department will determine whether your application is complete, and will issue a written notice of administrative completeness or deficiencies. After your application is complete, the Department will proceed with substantive review.

If the Department sends you a letter that your application is incomplete, the Department will include a comprehensive list of specific deficiencies. Until the missing information is received, both the administrative completeness review and the overall time frames will be suspended. When the Department receives the missing information, the administrative completeness review and overall time frames will resume. Your application will not be complete until all of the requested information is received. If you do not supply the missing information within sixty (60) days, the Department may deem your application withdrawn and close the file.

2) Substantive Review Time Frame

Within fifteen (15) days after the application is complete, the Department will review your application to determine whether it meets the substantive criteria required by statute or rule. By mutual written agreement between you and the Department, the time for substantive review may be extended by up to seven days.

During the substantive review, the Department may make one written request for additional information. You may also agree in writing to allow the Department to submit supplemental requests for additional information. If additional information is requested by the Department, both the substantive review and overall time frames will be suspended. When the additional information is received, the substantive review and overall time frames will resume.

At the end of the Department's substantive review, the Department will send you a written notice either granting or denying your application. If your application is denied, the notice will include the justification for the denial and an explanation of your right to appeal the denial.

Construction and Follow Up Requirements

1. Construction standards for abandonment must be in accordance with Department Rules.
2. Within thirty (30) days after abandonment, the well drilling contractor or single well licensee must file a Well Abandonment Completion Report with the Department.
3. The owner or operator of the well must also notify the Department in writing no later than thirty (30) days after abandonment has been completed. The notification should include the well owner's name, location of the well and the method of abandonment.
4. In course of drilling a new well, the well may be abandoned without an abandonment card. However, a Well Abandonment Completion Report must still be filed with the Department.
5. If an unregistered, open well is discovered within thirty (30) days of a change of ownership of real property, the new owner must notify the Department in writing within that thirty day period. This form will serve to register the well when properly abandoned and reported. Thereafter, the existence of any discovered open wells must be reported within ten days after discovery. A.R.S. § 45-593(D).

Enclosed is a copy of the Notice of Intent (NOI) to Abandon a Well. This NOI, which was recently filed with this Department is being returned to you as evidence of your compliance with ARS § 45-594; R12-15-816. The enclosed Well Owners Notification of Abandonment is to be submitted when the well has been properly abandoned. The Well Abandonment Card and Abandonment Completion Report forms have been sent to your driller. He may not begin abandonment until he has received the Well Abandonment Card. If you change drillers, you must supply this Department with the new driller's identity. Well abandonments shall be performed only by a licensed well drilling contractor or single well licensee.

ARS §45-594; R12-15-816(K) requires the registered well owner to submit a Well Owners Notification of Abandonment form within thirty (30) days after the abandonment of the well. It also requires the driller to furnish this Department a complete and accurate Well Abandonment Report within thirty (30) days after completion of abandonment. You should insist, and ensure, that both of these are done.

Dear Mr. Fallon:

Per our telephone conversation on November 21, 2001, this letter summarizes the agreed upon abandonment procedures for the two wells located in the right-of-way for expansion of the Interstate Highway System in Tucson, Arizona. Based on the results of the video logs that you submitted to ADWR, it appears that the perforations in the wells' casings are not sufficiently open to allow the grout material to fill the annular space between the casing and the borehole wall. Therefore, additional perforations are required for these wells, as follows:

- A 25-foot interval from 80 feet below ground surface (bgs) to 105 feet bgs shall be reperforated a minimum of two cuts per foot to allow the grout material to seal the annular space to prevent potential perched aquifer zones from migrating vertically down the borehole; and
- A 50-foot interval from 185 feet bgs to 235 feet bgs shall be reperforated a minimum of two cuts per foot to allow the grout material to seal the annular space to prevent potential cross-contamination between aquifer units. The estimated contact between aquifer units is approximately 210 feet bgs in the area.

Grout materials or mixtures must be emplaced under sufficient pressure to fill all voids including the annular space. A tremie pipe must be used to emplace the grout from the bottom-up. The end of the tremie pipe should remain in close proximity to the rising grout surface as the grout is pumped into the well. The type of grout material that will be used is a neat cement grout, which has a mixing ratio of one 94-pound sack of cement mixed with not more than six (6) gallons of water. The recommended amount of grout material should exceed the casing volume by approximately 30 percent. Please submit to ADWR the proposed volume of grout and the actual volume of grout used in the abandonment process.

In addition to the well sealing and abandonment methods, ADWR also requires a cement grout surface seal to be installed in the upper 20 feet of any well that is to be abandoned [Arizona Administrative Code R12-15-816 (H)(1) and (H)(2)]. As we discussed, you may either remove the casings from the upper 20 feet of the wells and set the cement grout from two (2) feet below the land surface to a minimum of



twenty (20) feet below the land surface. The wells must be backfilled above the top of the cement grout plug (2 feet below land surface) to the original land surface. Or you may perforate the upper 20 feet of the wells' casings which will ensure that the annular space outside the casings will be filled with cement from the land surface to a minimum of twenty feet below the land surface.

The Department approves your Notices of Intent to Abandon these wells if conducted in accordance with these requirements. However, this letter does not serve as the abandonment authorities. The abandonment authorities will be issued and an abandonment card will be mailed to your driller for each well. Once your driller receives the abandonment cards for these wells, you may proceed with the actual well abandonments.





Abandonment Plan - Well Numbers 55-501063 and 604024


ADOT plans to abandon the above wells in accordance with the Draft ADWR Well Abandonment Substantive Policy Statement, dated 11/20/99. Specifically, the wells will be video-logged to determine the well construction and to assess if the perforations are sufficiently open for grout to enter the annular space between the casing and the well bore.

After logging, the video log shall be evaluated. If it is determined that the perforations are sufficiently open, then the well will be pressure grouted with neat cement utilizing a tremie pipe from the bottom up which remains submerged within the grout while being pulled up as the grout rises. The neat cement will be injected at a sufficient pressure to fill all voids including the annular space and displace water from the well.

If the video log does not demonstrate that the perforations are open, the casing will be perforated a minimum of two cuts per foot from the bottom of the well to 20 feet above the highest known water level and the well pressure grouted as described above.


The volume of grout material applied will be measured and documented, with the goal of exceeding the casing volume by approximately 30 percent.



The upper 20 feet of casing will be removed, if the upper 20 feet is not already cement-sealed. If the upper 20 feet is sealed, then only the upper five feet of well casing will be removed. After removal of the surface casing, the boring will be sealed with neat cement.



ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION TO QUESTION NUMBER 14

The well is located in the Miracle Mile WQARF site, an area of known groundwater contamination in Tucson, Arizona. The WQARF area groundwater is commonly contaminated with TCE, PCE, and other industrial solvents and petroleum hydrocarbons.
