




EXPLANATION

The three ground water monitoring wells were installed as part of an investigation to determine the extent of contamination resulting from a leaking underground storage tank system.

Results of the investigation determined that soil contamination was present at levels which are below ADEQ soil remediation levels, and thus ADEQ allowed the soil to remain in place without cleanup.

Remediation was conducted on ground water to reduce the contaminant concentrations to levels which are below the Aquifer Water Quality Standards.

The attached letter states that ADEQ has closed the case, and that levels of soil and ground water contamination are below cleanup standards (no further action). We now wish to abandon the three ground water monitoring wells.

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Agers:

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Underground Storage Tank (UST) Corrective Action staff have reviewed the referenced leaking UST (LUST) case file(s). Based on this review, it has been determined that UST Program's investigative and remedial requirements have been satisfied. Therefore, further response concerning the referenced release reported to the ADEQ on May 12, 1999 is not required at this time.

This LUST case file has been closed for the following reasons:

1. The referenced release location was adequately investigated. The vertical extent of laboratory detectable soil contamination was adequately defined to less than 60 feet below the ground surface (bgs). The lateral extent of soil contamination was adequately defined to a radius of approximately 10 feet around the release location. The soil contamination was determined to be adequately defined as of July 17, 1999, based on the laboratory analysis date of characterization data.
2. Depth to groundwater beneath this facility has been measured to be 60 feet bgs. The source of this information is an on-site monitoring well where samples were collected on April 7, 2003.
3. Soil sampling data indicate that remaining contaminant concentration(s) are at or below the residential Soil Remediation Level(s) for petroleum hydrocarbon contamination and at or below the Groundwater Protection Level(s) for benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene, and total xylene contamination as specified in Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-7-201 et seq. for the identified contaminant(s). The highest soil contaminant concentration remaining in the subsurface soil included 790 mg/kg petroleum hydrocarbons at or about 15 feet bgs; 0.29 mg/kg ethyl benzene, and 2.7 mg/kg total xylenes at or about 45 feet bgs.
4. Monitoring data indicates that groundwater contamination has been less than or equal to Aquifer Water Quality Standard(s) for two consecutive sampling events. The most recent groundwater analytical results from samples collected on April 7, 2003 identified 50 µg/L ethyl benzene, 53 µg/L total xylenes, and 1.9 µg/L 1,2-Dichloroethane.

This letter shall not be construed as a determination by the ADEQ of the referenced facility's compliance with any other applicable laws and requirements. This letter does not affect the status of any other ADEQ Program or ADEQ LUST case for this facility. The ADEQ may revoke or amend this letter if any of the submitted information is determined to be inaccurate or if any condition was unknown to the ADEQ at the time this letter was issued. The ADEQ informs you that, pursuant to A.R.S. §49-1052 (M), you have one year from the date of receiving this case closure letter to submit final applications to the State Assurance Fund (SAF).

Informal and Formal Appeal Rights

Pursuant to A.R.S. §49-1091, you have 30 days after receipt of this letter to request an informal appeal to this interim decision. Any informal appeal should contain specific portions of this interim decision with which you disagree. The informal appeal process also allows you to request a meeting with the ADEQ. Because ADEQ staff have completed its review of all available data relating to the referenced UST release(s) and unless you disagree by filing an informal appeal, the ADEQ will adopt this interim decision as a final decision 31 calendar days after you receive this letter. When this decision becomes final, you have the right to appeal this decision in accordance with A.A.C. R18-12-610 and A.R.S. §41-1092.02 et. seq.


